

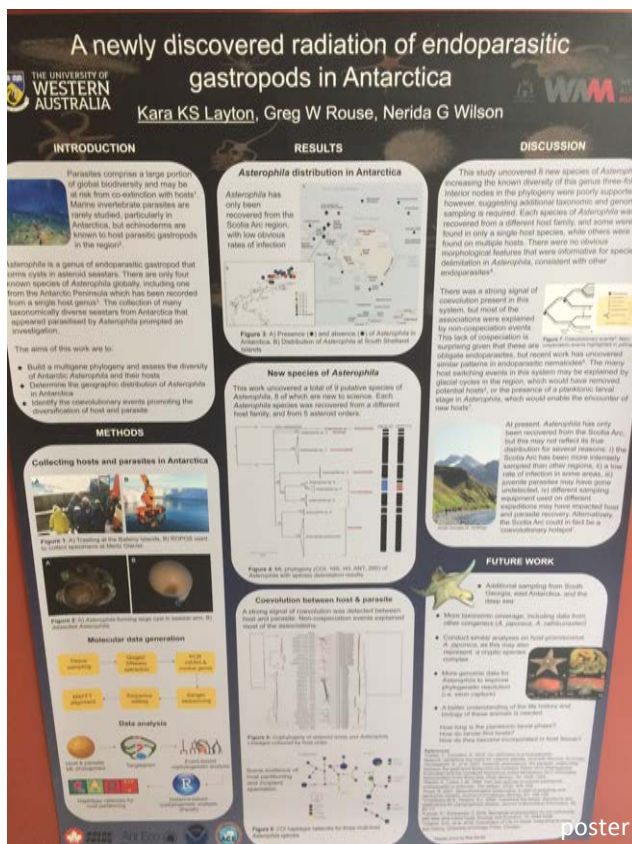
POLAR2018 Experience

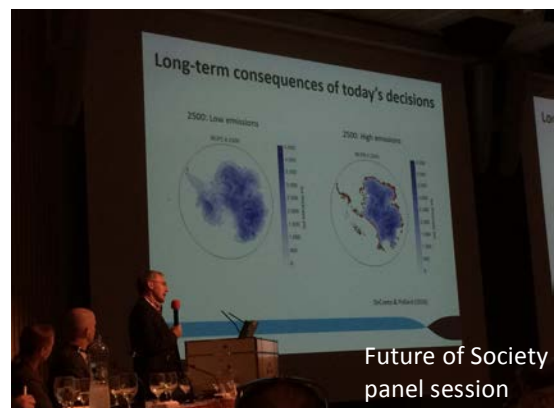
