Major outcomes

In May 2023, SCAR was represented at the 3rd session of UNGEGN, where we presented the Principles and Procedures for Antarctic Place Naming. The report was well received, and the group encouraged all to refer to the principles and procedures when naming in Antarctica.

The Antarctic Digital Database coastline database has been updated twice this year, in November 2022 (v7.6) and in May 2023 (v7.7). Changes in v7.6 include updates to the Amery Ice Shelf front, ice shelves and glaciers east of Law Dome, and sections of coast and ice shelf around Abbot Ice Shelf and Pine Island Glacier. Changes in v7.7 include updates Brunt Ice Shelf, ice fronts on the east side of the Antarctic Peninsula, Pine Island and Thwaites Glaciers and the ice fronts and coastline around Charcot Island. Data quality checks were also performed to ensure existing features were categorised correctly around Getz Ice Shelf.

New editions of the Antarctic Air Operations Planning Maps were released for the 2022/23 season, and discussions have taken place to review the maps in terms of input datasets and cartographic styling.

Updates to the SCAR Composite Gazetteer of Antarctica (CGA). As of 10 August 2023, the number of place names in the CGA is 39,140 (2022: 39,136).

Updates to the SCAR Map Catalogue. The Australian Antarctic Data Centre continues to manage the application and content for the SCAR Map Catalogue.

Upcoming activities

A workshop will be planned for early 2024 to review the Air Operations Planning Maps to ensure ongoing consistency, appropriate styling and to discuss new data sources for inclusion.

1. Antarctic Digital Database: seamless compilation of topographic data for Antarctica to 60°S. Consists of data downloads, and web map viewer (add.scar.org).
2. Antarctic Air Operations Planning Maps: Maps covering full air operations in Antarctic for planning flight operations. Compiled by UK, Australia, USA, Norway and Belgium.
3. Composite Gazetteer of Antarctica (CGA): compilation of all place names approved by all naming organisations of Antarctica. Consists of database and application.
4. SCAR Map Catalogue: compilation of Antarctic maps produced by SCAGI members
5. SCAR Feature Catalogue

Major Impacts

SCAR International Principles and Procedures for Antarctic Place Names Report published in October 2021 was presented at the 3rd Session of UNGEGN (United Nations Group of Experts on Geographic Names) in May 2023. The Group of Experts took note of the publication of the International Principles and Procedures and the effort made to encourage international standardization of Antarctic place names. The UNGEGN also encouraged all SCAR nations to reference the International Principles and Procedures when naming geographic features in the Antarctic and contribute named geographic features to the SCAR Composite Gazetteer of Antarctica.

Data update of coastline dataset in Antarctic Digital Database

SCAGI: 2022-23 Annual Report, cont.

Two data updates have been published to the coastline data in the Antarctic Digital Database, including major changes to ice shelves and fronts, including Amery Ice Shelf front, ice shelves and glaciers east of Law Dome, and sections of coast and ice shelf around Abbot Ice Shelf, Pine Island Glacier, Thwaites Glacier and the ice fronts and coastline around Charcot Island.

Continuation of Antarctic Air Operations Planning Maps

New editions were published for 2022/23 season. Project initiated by SCAGI in 2013 with aim to provide a consistent map series specifically for air operations with continent wide coverage.
