# EBA - summary

- Final year - winding up one year early to facilitate new programme startup
- No financial allocation for 2013 (allowed carry-over from 2012)
- Outputs (publications, workshops, conference sessions) continued as through life of programme
- Programme well regarded in international community
- No further budgetary or other approvals required
