Keynote talks on the opening day of the SCAR OSC will include the Weyprecht Lecture (Bob Bindschadler: glaciers, ice sheet mass balance and sea level), the Antarctic Science Lecture (Angelika Brandt: marine biodiversity), the 2012 Martha T. Muse Prize winner, and the thematic Policy Advice in a Changing World. Keynote lectures will be open to the public free of charge.

Portland is a vibrant, accessible city with a strong environmental stewardship ethic. Our universities, government agencies, and private sector are all recognized for their commitment to and innovation in sustainable practices and development.

SCAR Standing Scientific Group and subsidiary group meetings, and the Open Science Conference will all be held at the conference hotel, the Hilton Portland (921 SW Sixth Avenue). Registration will open in January 2012.

Portland State University will host the COMNAP Symposium, COMNAP AGM, and SCAR Delegates meetings on its campus, about a 10 minute walk from the conference hotel. Both the COMNAP Symposium and SCAR Keynote lectures will be open free to participants in both meetings.

A block of rooms has been reserved for SCAR and COMNAP participants at the Hilton Portland The room rate is \$169 USD plus local taxes and fees, per night. A limited number of University rooms will be available at \$25 USD, plus taxes and fees, per person for participants with demonstrable economic need. Accomodation details and applications for subsidized housing will be available at the conference website. The COMNAP Symposium, Sustainable Solutions to Antarctic Challenges: Supporting Polar Research in the 21st Century will also be open free of charge.
